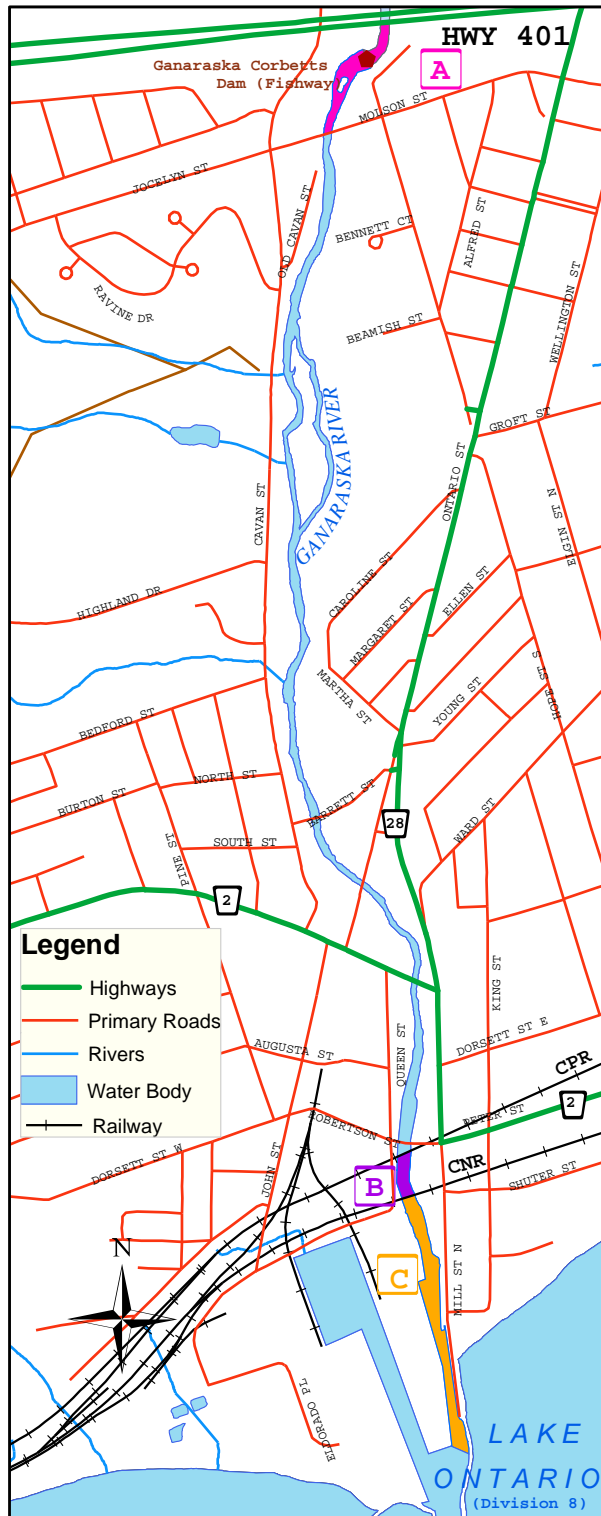


# Fishing Seasons for the Ganaraska River

## Port Hope Ontario, Division 6



The following provides fishing season information for the Ganaraska River, in the town of Port Hope from the south side of the bridge at Highway 401 downstream to Lake Ontario only. Information on other locations can be found in the annual Ministry of Natural Resources Fishing Regulations Summary.

### Fishing Division 6, Open Seasons

Pacific Salmon, Splake, Lake, Rainbow, Brown & Brook Trout  
 - Last Sat. in April to Sept. 30.  
 Sturgeon - Last Sat. in April to May 14 & June 15 to Nov. 15.  
 Atlantic Salmon - Closed all year.

Yellow Perch, Crappie & Whitefish - Last Sat. in April to Nov. 15.  
 Walleye, Sauger & Northern Pike - 2nd Sat. in May to Nov. 15.  
 Muskellunge - 1st Sat. in June to Nov. 15.  
 Largemouth & Smallmouth Bass - Last Sat. in June to Nov. 15.

### Additional Fishing Opportunities and Exceptions to the General Regulations



From Highway 401 downstream to the south side of the Jocelyn St. Bridge.

*Fish sanctuary - Closed all year.*



Between the south side of the CPR bridge and the southerly limit of the CNR right-of-way.

*Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout & Pacific Salmon  
 - Open last Saturday in April to December 31.*



Between the southerly limit of the CNR right-of-way and Lake Ontario.

*Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout, Atlantic Salmon, & Pacific Salmon  
 - Year-round open season.*
